Creating a Graphic Map for a Character

You will be producing a Graphic Map, looking at a character across a literature series. You will create a graphic representation of important events, people and places in your character's life.

Procedure:

- 1. Brainstorm significant events in the life of your character. These can be happy memories, sad memories, scary memories, important places, important people, life changing events, etc.
- 2. Think about what kind of picture or symbol would match each event listed.
- 3. Narrow your choices to the 8 to 10 most important events in the character's life. Arrange them in chronological order (which happened first, next, last).
- 4. Open the Online Graphic Map, and type in your name and the title for your graphic map.
- 5. On the next screen, you will be given a list of items. Choose "Other" and type in "Event".
- 6. The following screen asks for your rating system. Select "Positive/Negative".
- 7. The next screen asks you to enter your information.
 - a. EVENT serves as a label
 - b. TOPIC a word or phrase that tells what the item is
 - c. DESCRIPTION a longer explanation of the topic
- 8. The final step is to choose a picture. You have two options:
 - a. Selecting from a menu of clip art pictures
 - b. In the Miscellaneous Category, you can choose a border. When the graphic map prints out, you can draw your own picture.
- 9. When you are finished entering events, you will print your Graphic Map.
