

Vietnam Scavenger Hunt

Working in small groups, create an Internet WebQuest that explores the perspective of a particular group that was affected by the Vietnam War. People who complete your scavenger hunt should be able to tell others how the particular group was influenced and to draw conclusions about how the lasting effects.

Find Web sites that deal with your topic and develop ten questions that other students could answer by going to these sites.

Your finished scavenger hunt sheet should have a title, and introduction, ten questions, and list of sources. Use the Scavenger Hunt Template to publish your scavenger hunt on the Web site.
