Word Categories Rubric

Create a classification system that includes all the words on our class list.

- Your system should include at least five categories
- Each category should include at least four words on the list. You may use a word in more than one category, and you may add words from the book.

Once your categories are ready and your words all sorted, your group will make a word web and a poster. Your group will present your categories to the class. Each group member will also write an explanation of the categories and words included on the word web.
