

# Reading Display Requirements

**Use words and graphics in your display.**

- Print words in large, bold type that is easy to read.
- Include appropriate symbols or illustrations

**There is a balance between text and graphics (illustrations, symbols).**

- Too many graphics without explanation can create the same confusion as too many text blocks without graphics.

**The words are easy to read and spelled correctly.**

**Layout of the display effectively pays attention to:**

- the position of the text.
- the use of color.
- the use of illustrations.
- the use of symbols.

**The display is appealing and interesting enough to encourage others to read the text or to learn more about the author or genre.**

**The display looks neat and uses white space well.**

- The graphics and text should be evenly distributed around the display.

**The display meets the criteria of the rubric.**
