- 1. Assuming the persona of Richard Wright, write to the American citizens of the present about the most pressing aspect of the racial divide. Suggest solutions for bridging that divide.
- 2. Assuming the persona of a citizen of the present (you may choose the citizen's racial and class identity), write a letter to Richard Wright explaining why or why not he should be hopeful about the future.
- 3. Assuming the identity of Barack Obama, Professor Gates, Officer Crowley, or one of the Jena Six, explain how the events of *Black Boy* help shape your understanding of the contemporary racial divide.
