As you prepare your letter, consider what you learned from your reading, research, and discussion about

- People from the Middle East
- The effects and processes of immigration
- Issues related to growing up
- Adapting to a new place

Your ideas for welcoming this character should be based on what you have learned about the character's personality and circumstances, taking into account his or her life experiences, likes and dislikes, and reasons for coming to the United States.
