Directions for Making a Model of a Sandhill Crane

Materials:

- A sock (the color of the bird)
- Pipe cleaners for legs and feet
- Paper plates
- Felt or stiff construction paper for wings and beak
- Low-temperature glue gun
- Photographs of cranes from books (see List of Literature Resources) or the following websites:

Procedure:

- 1. Discuss and show photographs of the crane.
- Using felt, a paper plate, or construction paper make the wings and beak using the photographs as a reference. Cut into the correct shape and color the wings and beak.
- 3. Use pipe cleaners to make the legs and feet.
- 4. Color the wings, beak, legs, and feet.
- 5. Add color of shading to sock.
- 6. Attach wings, beak, legs, and feet with glue gun and let dry.
- 7. Put sock on arm and discuss the different parts.
- 8. Use the model crane as a puppet when retelling the story and describing an actual crane.
