- 3. What is surprising or puzzling? (to pique curiosity, to encourage risk-taking, reasoning, and flexible thinking)
- What helped you find a solution? (to articulate strategic thinking, to find patterns, to acknowledge the thinking of others)
- 5. What are you wondering? (to inspire further investigations, to perceive inquiry as an ongoing process)
